

# Netball Managers Roles and Responsibilities

Thank you so much for taking on the very important role of team manager! We would not be able to continue without your assistance.

## Manager's Responsibilities:

- Be the point of contact for communications between your team and the Chatswood Rangers.
- Ensure players/parents knows how to access **wet weather information** (on our Facebook page, on the NSNA website (nsna.nsw.netball.com.au) and will be emailed out to all managers).
- Ensure that you have a Working With Child Check for volunteers (WWCC).
- Ensure that you have a full team of players each week.
- **If you need an extra player** (referred to as 'Playing Up') you can contact the manager from the Manager's Contacts list for the teams below your team. i.e. Rangers 17 can borrow from Rangers 18 and below. Please remember to **email juniornetball@chatswoodrangers.com.au to notify of the child's name, date they are playing up, team they are playing up for and the team they are from. Remember a player can only play up in a team twice, if they play up for more than 2 occasions, they will automatically become part of that team.**
- Ensure all players are in correct uniform and have no jewellery and short nails.
- Ensure that the umpire, team captain and scorer for your team have signed scoresheet each game.
- Ensure that the kit bag (first aid kit, instant ice x 2, practice bibs, game bibs and match ball) and balls (5 x balls) are at each training session and game. You will need to return the kit bag and balls at the end of the season.
- Ensure all players/parents are familiar with Chatswood Rangers (chatswoodrangers.com.au) and NSNA websites (nsna.nsw.netball.com.au).
- Know the Code of Conduct & Club Rules, and ensure that players, parents, coaches, spectators and officials abide by it at all times.
